WHEREAS the American Dorper Sheep Breeders Society is recognized as the official breed registry for Dorpers and White Dorpers in the United States, and

WHEREAS the ADSBS is charged with developing bylaws, rules, regulations and policies in the best interests of the breeds, and

WHEREAS the ADSBS has encouraged the development of regional affiliated organizations to assist in promoting and expanding opportunities for breeders of Dorpers and White Dorpers, and

WHEREAS each regional affiliate, including the Western States Dorper Association, plays an essential role in promoting and marketing the breeds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the American Dorper Sheep Breeders Society and the Western States Dorper Association mutually agree to the following Memorandum of Understanding establishing a formal bond of support between the two organizations.

- (1) ADSBS agrees to allow WSDA use of the Society's trademarked logo for marketing and promotional purposes.
- (2) ADSBS declares that WSDA is an affiliated organization, and thus eligible for any ADSBS programs for funding assistance for activities.
- (3) WSDA agrees not to affiliate with any other organization related to Dorper and White Dorper sheep without the consent of ADSBS.
- (4) WSDA agrees to uphold the bylaws, rules, regulations and policies of ADSBS at all times. WSDA agrees NOT to have any such bylaws, rules, regulations or policies that are in conflict with those of ADSBS.
- (5) WSDA agrees to use Certified Dorper Judges for any affiliated show activity.
- (6) If requested by either party, ADSBS and WSDA agree to share financial statements, meeting minutes and or other official documents to the other.
